




As always the Sigma Pi brothers around the country partied just hard as they worked and enjoyed the city of New

fter virtually sweeping all of the Amajor award categories in New Orleans, the alumni felt that now was the perfect time to create an endowment to secure the chapter's future success. On December 1, 2006, the Delta-Beta Scholarship Fund was established with the Sigma Pi Educational Foundation. This is an endowment fund that is set-up specifically to invest donations from alumni, undergraduates, parents, businesses, and all other friends of the Delta-Beta Chapter. The earnings from these investments will then be used to fund scholarships for undergraduate brothers from the Delta-Beta Chapter.
