**Previous Chapter History:** Originally founded as a local fraternity, Alpha Theta Chi in 1959, the membership officially became a colony of Sigma Pi in 1965. Two years later the group was installed as the 99th chapter of Sigma Pi. The chapter flourished until the charter was revoked in 1975.

**Recolonization History:** In the spring of 1989, an interest group contacted the International Headquarters staff about becoming a part of Sigma Pi. On May 2, 1989, the Delta-Beta Colony was reborn. For the next two years the colony continually grew and prospered through the active campus participation. Finally, on

May 4, 1991 Delta-Beta was officially reinstalled.

**Campus:** Established as Monmouth Junior College in 1933, the school became a four year institution and was renamed Monmouth College in 1956. The campus included the Shadow Lawn estate, the former summer home of Woodrow Wilson. Today, Sigma Pi is one of four international fraternities on campus.
